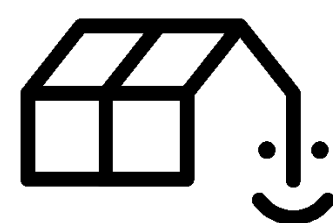
Neighborhood associations within the Central City Economic Development Sales Tax District may now apply for a \$2,500 grant to support neighborhood preservation efforts (lawn care, leaf removal, snow removal, etc.) that help prevent code violations for CCED residents.

- Neighborhood associations must be registered with the KCMO Department of Neighborhoods and Housing Services
- Neighborhood associations should be located within the CCED Sales Tax District, the area bounded by Indiana Avenue on the east, The Paseo Boulevard on the west, 9th Street on the north, and Gregory Boulevard on the south.

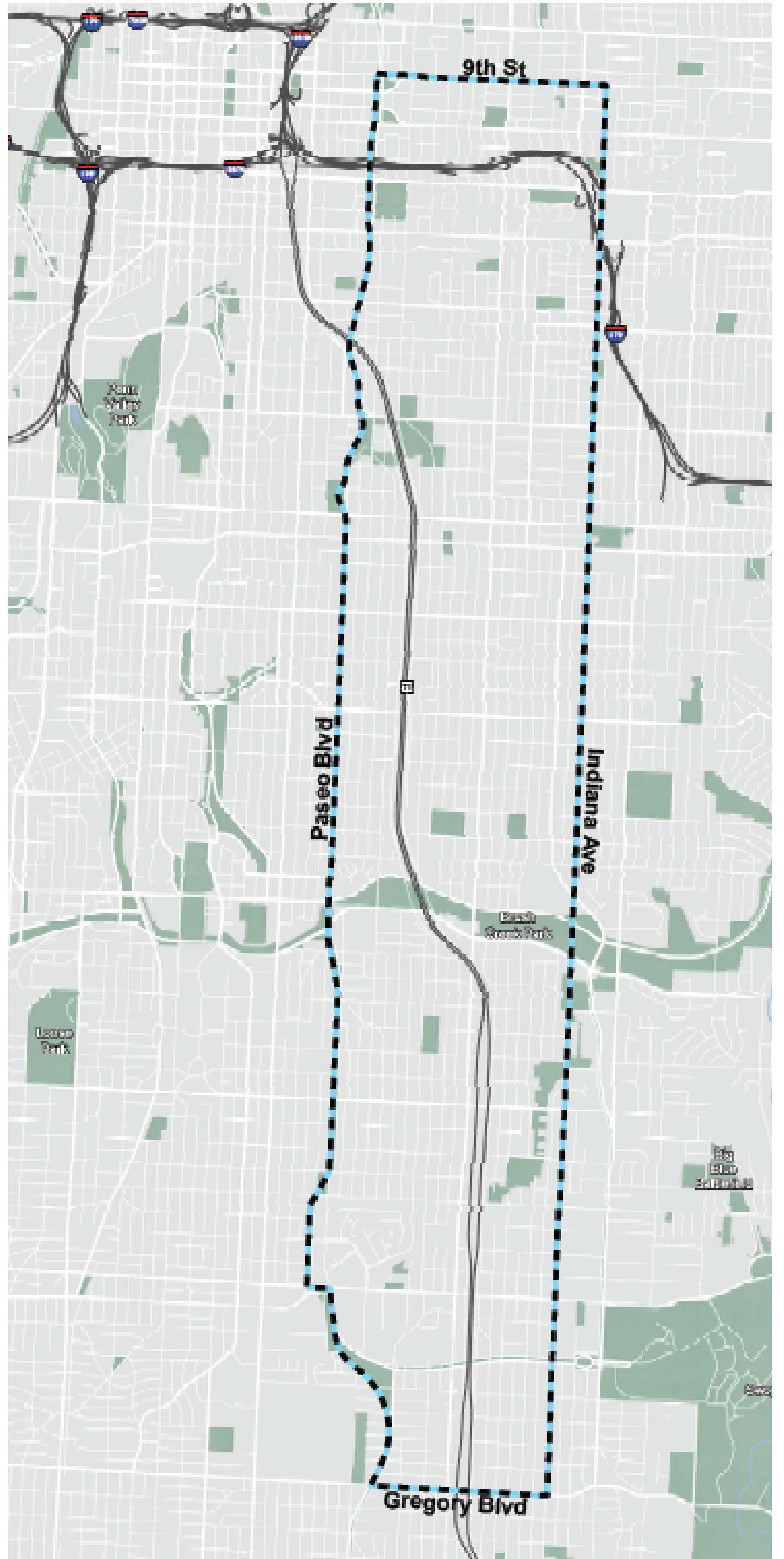

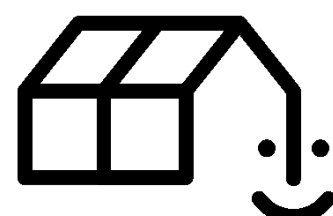
ELIGIBLE AREA

To apply for the CCED Community Stabilization Fund, neighborhoods must be registered with the City of Kansas City Missouri, and be within the CCED Sales tax District.

CCED is the area bounded by Indiana Avenue on the east, The Paseo Blvd. on the west, 9th Street on the north, and Gregory Blvd. on the south.
